Think about the most recent times when you have called out for Jesus. I find that it is in my most desperate times when I make that call, similar to the disciples in Matthew 8. They were doing their thing in a place of great familiarity,

the Sea of Galilee, when a violent storm came upon them.

You can imagine them doing all they could to maintain control, but then in verse 25, they "went and woke him [Jesus] saying, 'Lord, save us! We are going to drown!"

Notice that when they called for Jesus, He not only listened, but He was there. He was not playing it comfortable or safe in heaven. He was right there with them on the boat. And not only that, He was also willing to save them.

This has to be one of the most special qualities about Jesus. When life gets messy, difficult, and dirty, He is willing to meet you where you are. Ministry is messy because our lives often get messy. Yet, God is willing and able to lift us "out of the mud and mire," and give us a firm place to stand... The Rock that is Jesus (Psalm 40:20). To do that means engaging the mess, the mud, and the mire. If God is willing to do that for us, what about our willingness to do that for others? Let's roll up our sleeves and be there for others! See you this weekend!
