

#### Word From Our Pastor Jason Thomas

Who do you have to speak up for you? Last week, we were encouraged to pray for our church leaders. Truthfully, we all need someone to speak up for us through prayer. I recall one afternoon in fourth grade being pushed around by a kid who was much bigger than

me. Later, when my mom picked me up from school, she noticed a big knot that had come up on the side of my head. Of course, I tried to downplay the matter and reluctantly gave her the name of the "culprit" only after intense questioning. My mom did not make a big scene about it, but simply

spoke with my teacher to make sure that she would be there to look out for me in the future. Mom rightly believed that in my "tough" elementary school world, I needed an advocate.

In our "tough" world, prayer is an important way for us to speak up for each other. Each prayer that we speak is received in heaven and presented to God through the one who stands at His right hand. Jesus is the righteous one "who speaks to the Father in our defense" (1 John 2:1). Because He is our high priest and mediator, "[l]et us then approach the throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need" (Heb. 4:16).

Let's all be encouraged to speak up and pray for each other as we work together to carry out God's mission in our "tough" world. See you this weekend! Jason

# Discipleship

Spiritual maturity is not knowing everything nor is it acting like you know everything. Everyone feels the pressure of embarrassment when we face situations where we do not know what to do. Spiritually mature people do not "fake it till they make it." They take responsibility by learning from it and pursuing to learn from others before them. The spiritually immature blame others and cannot properly handle pressure of what to do next with what they face.

Go through the people of Scripture, notice how each one takes responsibility or blames others for their actions. Begin with Adam and Eve, they did everything to avoid taking responsibility for their sin. Adam blamed his wife. He even pointed an accusing finger at God, saying it was "the woman, whom You gave me." Eve

passed the blame to the serpent. Their excuses did not/ make а difference in

the consequences for their actions. God knows the difference in excuses and rationale. God's sovereignty overpowers our sin and our inadequacy. Have confidence in the mercy of God. Jesus did. God's mercy is the only value of worth to overcome sin.

When we refuse to take responsibility for our actions, we want to blame others for our problems, sin, even our lack of experience or knowledge. Yet forgiveness and restoration cannot happen until we accept full responsibility for our actions. If we make a habit of blaming others for our failures, we will not reach a point of honest repentance. God will hold us accountable for our own actions, not others (2 Cor. 5:10). Strive always to acknowledge and take responsibility for your own sins. Lean into His power to

overcome your inadequacy. It will free you to receive God's forgiveness and to press on to spiritual maturity.
