Do you pray with the expectation that God will answer you? Do you tremble when God speaks? When was the last time you were affected by the reality that Almighty God just spoke directly to you? The apostle John lost all physical strength when God spoke to him in Revelation. Paul fell to the ground when Jesus met him on the road to Damascus. Moses trembled when God spoke to him. And Peter, when he realized who Jesus was, fell down at Jesus' knees, saying, 'Depart from me, for I am a sinful man, O Lord!'

It is easy to lose our sense of awe that the Almighty God chooses to speak to us. You are probably thinking, "Well Andy, were not all those audible encounters?" Allow me to

respond with this question.

Do you approach the reading of Scripture with a holy expectation, listening for the life-changing

words that God personally has for you that day? Scripture says that "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom." There are things you will see and hear out of your fear and reverence for God that you will not experience in any other way than by being engrossed by God's Word and hearing directly from him.

As you study Scripture, you may sense that God has something to communicate directly through the verses you are reading. Take a moment to consider the awesome reality that the Holy Spirit is now speaking to you. If Jesus could speak and raise the dead, calm a storm, cast out demons, and heal the incurable, then what effect might a word from Him have upon your life.
