There is a significant difference between judgment and discernment. God sees people's hearts and knows their motives. Only God can accurately judge those who deserve punishment. Ultimately, Christ will sit in judgment upon us all in the day of judgment. Our problem is that we like to sit in the judgment seat instead of the mercy seat. Scripture commands us not to judge or condemn others, for we cannot be judgmental and redemptive at the same time. God's kindness and thus our kindness is intended to lead to repentance. It is difficult to pray sincerely for someone while we are judging them. Scripture reminds us that God will treat us with the same grace or severity with which we treat

others. God commands us not to judge others, but He does want us to be discerning. Jesus said

we would know people's spiritual condition by the fruit of their lives. He said grapes are not produced by thorn bushes. If a person's life produces thorns, we can assume that person is not a grapevine! Are we being judgmental? No, we are being discerning. This past weekend we were challenged from God's Word to invest spiritually into others who in turn will invest spiritually into others, continuing for generations. What an incredible call on our lives!


Here are some "takeaways" that I identified for my life:
