This used to be me... Moments before the big football game, I would find myself praying to God in hopes that my team would emerge victorious. Chances are that while I was lifting up my prayer, there was someone else praying a very similar prayer for the team on the other side. How was God supposed to answer those prayers? Was He simply going to answer with the goal of providing

> me or the other "quy" with temporary happiness? Could it be that God was and is working in ways that are much bigger than our temporary happiness? lf you have followed Jesus for very long, then you know that the source of your happiness is much bigger than what you can find in the temporary. Jesus knew from his time on earth that there are too many ups and

downs for happiness to be found in the Maybe that is why He temporary. reminded His disciples, "...my peace I give vou. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid" (John 14:27).

To many of the scribes, the Scriptures were meaningless theological speculation, but Jesus taught them as the living words of God. When the religious leaders searched the Scriptures, they came away emptyhanded. When Jesus read the very same Scriptures, the Father gave Him a full measure of His wisdom and His authority.
