#### Word From Our Pastor Jason Thomas

If I told you that image is everything, some of you will think back to the 1989 TV commercials. in which tennis star Andre Agassi used those words to promote the then state-of-the-art Canon EOS Rebel camera. Though the camera and those commercials have come and

> gone, the words "Image is Everything," are still very relevant and important. In fact, they have been since the beginning of human history. Consider this... "Then God said, 'Let us make mankind in our image, after our likeness....' So God created man in his own

Another reason we are led by a team of singers and musicians instead of a songleader, is again a Biblical model.
