

Word From Our Pastor

Imagine yourself this week walking down one of the aisles at the local grocery store. Just as you push your buggy up to get your favorite breakfast cereal, you bump into an old friend... Who proceeds to ask you about your church. What would you say to your friend? Would you say that church is a place that you go to once or twice a week?

Would you be able to articulate the mission of your church or what makes your church special?

Our word for "church" comes from the Greek word "Ecclesia," which refers, not to a place, but to a people who are called by God. They are called out to be God's people who gather

together, but who also do more than gather. We don't see this type of dynamic in the Bible or in human history until Acts 2, with the pouring out of the Holy Spirit. From that moment, God began calling people through the preaching of the gospel and the leading of the Spirit. These people gathered in small groups and large groups, they worshiped together, they spent time together, and they served together in the name of Jesus.

What we see in Acts is the church consisting of ordinary people called to be and make disciples of Jesus. Their mission, very simply, was to **gather** together, to **grow** spiritually, and to **go** out and make a difference... All for the glory of God. That is still who we are as a church and that is still our mission today. What makes us unique at FBCFO is that we are doing this as one, big **family**. You will never find a more loving faith family than right here at FBCFO! Let's gather together this Sunday and celebrate who we are in Christ! -Jason

Discipleship

Read Psalm 68 during this Valentine season. God's love for His children is higher than our imagination! Our broken and limited experience of human love hinders us from understanding God's unconditional love. We can see this depth and width of His love in the life of Hosea.

Hosea was a righteous man, but God told him to marry a sinful woman. Hosea obeyed and took Gomer to be his wife. He cherished her and treated her with dignity and respect. Never before had Gomer experienced this kind of love, but she soon grew dissatisfied. She began giving her affections to others. She became so involved in these pursuits that finally she abandoned Hosea altogether. These other men used her until she had nothing left to give. Then they sold her into slavery. After this tragic and painful course of events, God gave Hosea a gospel-infused command: "Go and buy her back." Despite

the intense hurt that Gomer had inflicted on him, God told Hosea to forgive her and to pay whatever price he needed to bring her back and restore her into his home. We must identify with Gomer. God shows us the great distance he is willing to go so that we would be in relationship with Him.

After all of God's efforts, it is incomprehensible that we should reject Him. But it is even harder to fathom that God would pursue us even after we have rejected, ignored, and disobeyed Him. Yet God's love is completely different from ours. **His love follows us to the depths of our sinfulness until He has reclaimed us as His own!** His love is undaunted when we run from Him, and He continues to pursue us.

What great love has He demonstrated to us that we don't understand it but he still has it!

Forever! I love that word, for it carries with it a great promise. Eternity is ours... And eternity is something we don't have to wait for: It is happening now! *(Seeing ourselves as spiritual beings rather than physical beings, we see ourselves as part of the eternal world rather than the physical world.)*

May I encourage us to have powerful personal times of worship every day. And then when we gather with other Believers, passionately and intimately worship the Lord. Don't just go through the motions, but immerse yourself in worshipping Him! **Worship Well!**
