## Discipleship

We must embrace a discipline of examining why we follow Christ. Its like stirring up ambers of a burning fire that we want to be ablaze. We have a tendency to find our "comfort zone" and then position ourselves firmly in place. If we do this, our fire will become glowing ashes. If we are in a situation or lifestyle where we are perfectly capable of handling everything, chances are we have stopped growing in our understanding of God.

God's desire is to take us from where we are to where He wants us to be. This stirring of the fire is dangerous, smoke increases, sparks could fly out and we could get burned. But it remains needed. We will always be one step of obedience away from the next truth God wants us to learn about Him. You may experience a restlessness whereby you sense that there is far more you should be learning and experiencing about the Father.

Perhaps we need to trust God to a degree we never have before. This is how a passion for Christ burns. Our God is a consuming fire. To be closer to Him is to be in the danger zone, not the comfort zone.

These men had to disrupt their comfortable zones in order to reach new heights in their relationship with the Lord. Likewise, in order to experience God to the degree He wants you to. there will be adjustments He will ask of you. Are you prepared for Christ to reveal Himself to you in dimensions that will change your life? Are you willing to
