He could not control the productivity of the flocks and herds, but he could control his own response to God. He chose to praise the Lord.

Do things seem to be falling apart around you? You can still praise God. Our emptiness is an opportunity to be filled up. Your praise for Him does not depend on the success of your life but on God's nature and His love and faithfulness to us. Let's ask God to help us look past earthy concerns to
