# Discipleship

As disciples of Christ, we often hear God's voice through prayer, His Word, and His messengers. Yet, we sometimes fail to hear God speak through His activity, even though He is working all around us. Celebrate and value spiritual awareness, whether acknowledging God's activity or recognizing the enemy's plots. God encourages His people to watch for His activity so they will know how they should respond and adjust their lives. Praying without ceasing, also involves a nonverbal responsiveness to seeing what God does and simply acting. This is much like a matured married couple who communicate well through their teamwork apart from solely their verbal dialogue.

The disciples discovered much about God's power by witnessing Jesus calming a raging storm with a command. Seeing Jesus dine with the notorious sinner. Zacchaeus, taught them a poignant message about God's love for sinners. Watching Jesus hang upon the cross communicated
