

Discipleship

Our society is full of "experts." There are people everywhere who want to convince you of the wisdom of their opinion. Yet God says that it is not the one who declares his viewpoint the most loudly or vociferously who is the wisest, but the one who is vindicated over time. Wisdom is not proven by argument or debate. Wisdom acknowledges there are unknowns but focuses on faith moment by moment. Wisdom is proven over time. Some people adamantly proclaim that their opinion is best. Regardless of how convincingly these people defend their viewpoint, time is the best judge of their wisdom. The result of a practice proves its validity, not how loudly it is promoted. The more we experience Christ, the more we realize our need of Him. When you seek to be conformed to God, you will sometimes meet resistance and criticism from others who disagree with the wisdom of your actions. Your immediate

response may be the urge to vindicate vourself. Have the patience of Christ. Love them. If you wait

patiently, time will reveal the wisdom of your actions far better than you could through argument.

Through the ages, the wisdom found in God's Word has been tested and revealed to be true. It is critical that you measure everything you hear against the Scriptures and the Discerning Divine Spirit. Society's values are consistently changing. but our revelation of God through Jesus is timeless. Whenever you share an opinion in counseling someone else, make sure that it comes from the Christ of Scripture and not merely from your best thinking. As long as you base your life values and perspectives on Christ being the exact image of God, time will be your defender and will validate the wisdom of your choices. If, over time, you clearly see you were mislead, return to life,

> teachings and passion of Jesus. Then seek to be conformed to eternal mystery of Christ and watch to see God confirm His wisdom through faith. Let's be conformed seeking the

(Habakkuk 2:14) There is a powerful prophetic message in this verse for all of us! All throughout Scripture are promises of God's intent and purpose that will come to pass. In the above verse, we are given a prophetic word that we can have a hand in fulfilling, in helping it come to pass.

God says that the earth will be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the Lord. We can help fill the earth with the knowledge of the glory of the Lord. How? By simply filling the atmosphere with praise! Speak His praises, sing His praises, shout His praises.

And we can go further in what we say and sing: Instead of saying and singing about our problems and difficulties (and God coming to our rescue), say and sing about the greatness of God (without mentioning vourself).
