Word From Our Pastor Jason Thomas

You can make a difference! Last week in our newsletter series on Growing Pains, I asked you to begin thinking about the people who come to a worship service here for the first time. As I mentioned last week, though we might forget, coming to our church campus for the first time can be a very intimidating

experience. So what can we do to connect well with new people and remove any barriers that stand between them and a saving relationship with Jesus? Consider this goal for our

Sunday morning Worship Celebration: For every disciple and guest to be engaged in a regular worship experience that

promotes personal, authentic worship and is empowered by the Spirit and Word of God. Engaging new people makes the difference, and begins now with prayer. Let's pray now for God to show Himself strong in our Worship Celebration this Sunday and for our hearts to be ready for Him.

And as we are prayed up, we're ready to invite in. People like to be invited. The invite might be to someone you know or someone you just met. It might come when people see us serving in the community and become interested in our mission. Let's be disciples who introduce new people to Jesus through a personal invite. And when they come, let's be ready to greet them at our Coffee Cafe and help them navigate to the Starting Line during the 9:30 am hour or the Worship Center during the 10:55 am hour. Join me in praying now for this Sunday, and together we will BE the ones who engage well! -Jason

Discipleship

At first glance, it appears a faithful thing that Jesus' disciples kept such careful guard over the orthodoxy of Jesus' ministry. Then they found someone casting out demons in Jesus' name who was not a part of *their* group and not under *their* control, and they demanded that he stop. Hear them say "they don't know Jesus like we know Jesus!" Yet Jesus saw through His disciples' hypocrisy and exposed their heart. The disciples themselves had been given the power to drive out demons as well (Matt. 10:8), yet they had failed miserably (Mark 9:28). God is always bigger than what we assume.

How it must have embarrassed the disciples to have publicly failed to cast out a demon from a young boy. Yet, here was someone successfully exorcising demons who was not even regularly with Jesus as they were. They should have been concerned with their own lack of spiritual power and vitality. Can you feel them comparing themselves? They should have felt

convicted by their Lord's stinging rebuke at their lack of faith (Matt. 17:20). Instead, they focused on others. Rather than repenting of their sin and grieving over their spiritual impotence, the disciples attempted to hinder someone who was enjoying spiritual success.

At times, it is easier to diminish others' spiritual victories than to honestly confront our own failures. All great spirituality comes correctly dealing with our failures. Jesus' response to His disciples must have surprised them as He said, "Do not forbid him" (Mark 9:39). He assured them that "he who is not against us is on our side" (Mark 9:40). Have you learned this vital lesson? That comparisons are vanity? Are you able to genuinely rejoice in the spiritual victories of others? In the age of social media, it is consistently in front of

> us. But abundant life and joyful victories should be celebrated for all good things come from our Father in heaven
